DETAILED BACKGROUND:

The Local Collaborative Time Study (LCTS) funds are continuing to benefit programs in the district. This year ISD 271 was awarded \$64,000 to fund three school district programs during the 2019 calendar year. The table below shows a 10 year history of LCTS grant awards.
